Scrum Overview – 1 day

Scrum is an established Agile process that can be used to manage and control complex software and product development using iterative, incremental practices. It has become increasingly well-used as a lightweight Management wrapper for other Agile methods, and is often used alongside eXtreme Programming.

Through discussion, practical exercises and Case Studies, this course explains the rationale for Scrum, what it is and how it works – and the benefits that it delivers.

Audience

This course is suitable for anyone who requires an overview of Scrum, but does not need the detailed level of understanding required by members of a Scrum Project Team, or those involved in transitioning to Scrum within their own organisation.
